# **Project location**





## Purpose and need

- Highway importance
  - West Wausau Avenue is an important route serving residential and school traffic on the west side of Wausau
- The City's objective is to ensure the safe and efficient operations of the local roadway system while supporting local access needs



## Purpose and need

- The City has received federal funding through the WisDOT Local Road Program to address needs
  - 0.3 mile of West Wausau Avenue
- The existing pavement has met the end of its service life
  - Concrete pavement constructed in 1968
  - Cracking and deterioration present throughout



## Purpose and need

- In addition to deteriorated pavement, other needs exist along West Wausau Avenue
  - City of Wausau municipal utilities (sewer and water) are deteriorated
  - Existing curb ramps at Stevens Drive and along the north side of West Wausau Avenue do not meet Americans with Disability Act (ADA) Standards
  - There is a lack of pedestrian accommodations along the south side of the roadway



## **Proposed improvements**

- Reconstruct pavement
  - Full pavement reconstruction with 12-foot travel lanes and 8-foot parking lanes (where present)
  - Replace curb and gutter
- Replace storm sewer drainage inlets
- Reconstruct sanitary sewer and water main
- Improve pedestrian accommodations



#### Pedestrian accommodations

- Reconstruct existing curb ramps to meet ADA standards
  - Replace curb ramps on east side of Stevens Drive
  - Replace curb ramps on north side of West Wausau Avenue
  - No work planned
    - Curb ramps on the west side of Stevens Drive will be replaced by the City under a separate project, if required
    - Curb ramps at North 10th Avenue were replaced in 2023



#### Pedestrian accommodations

- North side of roadway
  - Reconstruct existing 8-foot sidewalk abutting curb
- South side of roadway
  - Evaluate addition of sidewalk to improve pedestrian connectivity through the project area
  - 6-foot sidewalk abutting curb to minimize impacts
- Per City code, clearing of snow on sidewalk is required by adjacent property owners



# Proposed construction staging

- Construction proposed June to August 2026
  - Avoid/minimize impacts to the school year
- Proposed traffic impacts
  - Alternative access points are available during summer to the school from Stevens Drive and North 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue
  - Provide for residential access
  - Maintain emergency services



#### Real estate

- Right of way and temporary easements
  - Temporary easements will be required for blending slopes, driveway match points, staging, and utility connections
  - Minor fee acquisition may be required near curb ramps
- City of Wausau will acquire real estate
  - A real estate representative will be hired
- Estimated real estate needs shown on the exhibits
- Real estate brochure available



#### **Environmental considerations**

- Temporary easements are required from the Wausau West School property
  - The building is a potential historic resource
  - The property is used by the public for recreation
  - Requires special consideration in the environmental document for the project

## Current project schedule

- Project initiation Fall 2023
- Public involvement meeting February 29, 2024
- Preliminary plans April 2024
- Plan and report approvals Spring 2024
- Right of Way Plat Summer 2024
- Real Estate Acquisition Summer 2024 to Summer 2025
- Final plans August 1, 2025
- Construction Summer 2026

Additional public involvement meetings may be scheduled during the design and construction process.
