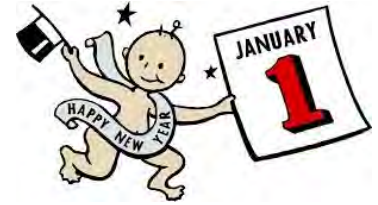

Happy Holidays Longfellowers! Amongst the hustle and bustle of December, the County Board is wrapping up the previous year's work and setting up priorities for 2023. Each committee is making a plan so I recommend visiting the Marathon County Board Calendar to see the agendas of the standing committees where you can find the January meetings when each should be discussing them. I serve on the Human Resources, Finance, and Property committee. The following are areas our team has identified as priorities:

- (Finance) ARPA & other Federal grants: establish criteria for the review and ranking of projects
- (Property) Tax Delinquent, County Properties, and Long-Term Facilities Plan: establish goals, guidelines, and processes for dealing with each
- (Human Resources) Cultural Competence: develop, plan, and monitor implementation of policies to address cultural competencies within county programs and services
- (Finance/Property) Tax Increment Financing: evaluate the impacts that TIDs have county wide and develop recommendations on changes to state laws; Evaluate county participation on Joint Review Committees as well as decide criteria for evaluating TIF plans
