Porch Rebuild

- -Call 811 to schedule utilities locates.
- -Safely jack up porch overhang and support with temporary structural bracing.
- -Demo porch decking, structure, existing footings, concrete stairs & slab and dispose of properly.
- -Dig down 4.5 ft. Frame forms for footings. Pour concrete and let cure. Install pier forms plumb, level and square. Pour concrete and let cure.
- -Frame porch substructure using 3ply 2x12 beam, 6x6 posts, 2x10 joists.
- -Apply joist protective tape to prolong the life of the deck structure.
- -Install composite decking and secure with corrosion resistant fasteners.
- -Frame new staircase and secure.
- -Get framing Inspection done.
- -Install new structural white columns to support porch overhang, lower roof and secure. Install new white aluminum railings between columns and down stairs.
- -Install brick facade around post bases.
- -Install new white composite lattice.
- -Post Construction Cleanup
- -Final Inspection
